## **COATS PATONS COLLECTION**

## **Textile Factories, Launceston**

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#### INTRODUCTION

In 1920 one of the first decisions of the newly formed British textile company Patons and Baldwins Limited was to establish a mill in Australia. Launceston was selected as the site by two company directors: there was a good supply of soft water, a constant source of cheap electric power and ready availability of labour, with climatic conditions similar to those in Britain. It was the first overseas manufacturing venture for the company.

Land was purchased at Glen Dhu in Launceston, site preparation started in 1921 and local firm Hinman, Wright and Manser commenced construction of the brick, concrete and steel building in 1922. Skilled craftsmen together with their families brought from Patons and Baldwins English and Scottish factories formed the nucleus of the workforce. They trained local people and the mill began production in August 1923. Wool was processed from the raw material to the finished yarn for hand and machine knitting. The company reached full production in November with a staff of 100. In 1924 cottages were built in Heather and Glen Dhu streets to house some of the British personnel.

Over the years a number of extensions and additions were made to the factory. A handsome canteen and social hall was built in 1941-42 on land acquired directly opposite the mill in Thistle Street.

During the Second World War the plant ran almost non-stop on government and military contracts. After the war the company's well known brands of hand knitting yarns returned to prominence. In the decade following 1955 the mill was refurbished and extended, doubling the size of the mill to cover a site of nearly 50 acres.

By 1966 the Launceston mill was the largest mill of its type in the southern hemisphere and the state's biggest employer of women. Employment peaked at 2100 before the end of the decade. When Patons and Baldwins amalgamated with J & P Coates in 1969 the company was renamed Coats Patons (Australia) Ltd.

Annual bonuses were paid to employees and the company provided its own medical, hospital, sickness and dental scheme (see CHS 28, Coats Patons Employees' Mutual Benefit Society) and superannuation fund. Employees had their own savings fund and also formed social and recreational clubs, including a bowling club established on an adjoining site in 1964.

A satelite production unit to manufacture synthetic yarn commenced at George Town in 1967, but closed in 1976.

Bonds Industries Ltd, Sydney, merged with the Australian interests of the UK textile group Coats Patons Ltd in 1970. Due to dramatic changes in tariff policies in the early 1970s the company rationalised its operations, decreasing its workforce and concentrating on the production of quality hand knitting yarns.

In 1987 the Launceston operation was renamed Coats Patons Handknittings. The company was restructured in 1991 and the Coats Semco operation and Coats Patons Handknittings amalgamated to form Coats Patons Crafts. The Coats Semco operation, a factory manufacturing and warehousing for tapestry and embroidery, was relocated from Melbourne to the Launceston mill.

Inexpensive synthetic imports and the declining popularity of hand knitting caused demand to decrease in the late 1980s and in 1997 the parent company decided to move the Launceston operations to New Zealand.

After 75 years operating on its 9.3 hectare site in Launceston, the factory closed on 31 July 1997. (See *Launceston Week*, 4 July 1997, pp. 13-15; *Examiner Extra*, 19 July 1997, pp. 4-5)

The collection was donated to the Queen Victoria Museum and Art Gallery in 1997 and 1998.
