A SOLID FOUNDATION

Welcome to the QVMAG Arts Foundation. Established in 1985, the Foundation's objective is to assist in the maintenance, development and improvement of the collections of QVMAG. In particular, the Foundation aims to attract and encourage donations, gifts, bequests, endowments, trusts and other forms of financial assistance to, and for the benefit of, QVMAG.

QVMAG is a significant cultural asset which is publicly owned through the City of Launceston and funded by the ratepayers of Launceston with support from the Tasmanian Government. It holds the most important collection of cultural material in regional Australia, having received all its treasures through public involvement.

To maintain QVMAG's place in the cultural space it must continue to nurture and grow collections. The Foundation is an important means of enhancing the Decorative and Fine Arts collections and an excellent way to give back to the community whilst creating a valuable resource for future generations.

The Foundation is managed by an elected Management Committee of up to twelve members, appointed for a term of one year but able to be re-elected under the rules. Annual General Meetings are conducted and all members are welcome to attend.

MEMBERSHIP

The Foundation has a Constitution that allows for individuals to be elected as members when that person commits to support the Foundation's objectives by way of a donation:

- Any past donor to the Foundation is entitled to membership. Please apply in writing to the Public Officer with any available evidence of your donation.
- Any person may apply for a membership of the Foundation by sending the completed attached form to the Public Officer. Once processed, the applicant will be advised and, upon payment of their donation, will become a member, subject to the rules set out in the Constitution.

There are five categories of membership available:

General Member Donation of \$ 1,000
Fellow Donation of \$ 5,000
Benefactor Donation of \$10,000
Trustee Donation of \$25,000
Governor Donation of \$50,000

All further donations count cumulatively towards the qualification for other categories of membership.

Each membership is for an individual person, or a person acting as the nominated representative of a company or other body.

Donations qualifying for General Membership may be made in quarterly installments. All donations over \$2 are tax deductible.
