#### INTRODUCTION

John Presnell Kenworthy was born in Hobart in 1855, to Robert Kenworthy and Ann Sarah Presnell. In 1880 he married Constance White, daughter of Pastor W White, of Launceston.

John and Constance had five children, Mercia, May, Robert, Herbert and Harold. Whilst in Launceston, the family were active in the St John's Friendly Society. John was a keen musician and for some years was secretary of the Launceston Musical Association. It is likely that John sang alongside his brother Albert and father Robert in the choir of the 1891/92 International Exhibition held in Launceston.

They moved to Latrobe around 1891 where John opened his drapery store the Mersey Boot Arcade, previously the Mersey Book Arcade, in 1892. JP Kenworthy was a member of the town board of Latrobe, a member of the Latrobe Chamber of Commerce and served as treasurer of the North Western Agricultural Association. In the 1890s he maintained an interest in various mining companies. He also sang in the St Luke's Church Choir at Latrobe. Constance Kenworthy was a supporter of the Latrobe Horticultural Society until her death in 1926. Mr Kenworthy died a little over four years later in 1931. Both Constance and John Kenworthy are buried at Carr Villa Memorial Park, Launceston.

Kenworthy's drapery and clothing store continued to be run by the Kenworthy family after the death of Mr Kenworthy. It remained in Kenworthy hands until it closed in May 1992. Mercia Kenworthy, John and Constance's last surviving child, died the following year in June 1993. She was 92 years old, and had worked in the store since the age of 16, remaining involved in the running of the store until its closure.
