INTRODUCTION

The first Rotary Club was established in Chicago, USA, in 1905. The movement soon became widespread and the name Rotary International was adopted in 1922 as similar clubs were established in other countries. The organisation is divided into districts. Rotary International created the Rotaract Programme for young men and women 18-29 years of age to provide an opportunity for their personal development, community service and social interaction. In 1995 there were 6,457 Rotaract Clubs in 124 countries.

The first steps towards the formation of the North Launceston Rotaract Club, within Rotaract District 983, were taken by the North Launceston Rotary Club in September 1970. An initial Interest Meeting was held on 16 March 1971 and office bearers were elected at an Organisational Meeting on 30 March. There were 26 foundation members. From 1974, two members were invited to attend the parent Rotary Club meetings on a regular basis. However, the inability to sustain membership finally led to the North Launceston Rotaract Club's termination twenty years later, on 31 March 1991.

The North Launceston Rotaract Club met variously at Burwood, Invermay, Our Lady of Christians Catholic School, George Town Road, the Royal Hotel, George Street, Ripples Restaurant and other venues. Its activities included fund raising, especially through gate attendance for the Northern Tasmanian Trotting Association meetings at the Elphin Showgrounds, assistance to the Mowbray Memorial Swimming Pool Complex, Self Help's newspaper recycling project, Mowbray Health Clinic, City Mission, Launceston City Council, the Orana Hostel and other community organisations, tenpin bowling, cricket and other social occasions. It also had regular contact with other Rotaract Clubs in Tasmania.

The collection was donated to the Queen Victoria Museum and Art Gallery in August 1995.
