INTRODUCTION

The furniture manufacturing company, James Bradley's Pty Ltd, was established in August 1985 in Invermay by James Bradley. Originally from the United Kingdom, Bradley received his training at the London College of Furniture, attaining a Diploma of Arts and Design. He moved to Australia in 1985 and taught briefly at the Sydney College of the Arts. After seeing the opportunity to work in Tasmanian timbers, he moved to Tasmania and founded the company.

James Bradley's Pty Ltd specialised in making wooden furniture in small quantities, particularly tables and chairs. Much of the furniture produced was in contemporary classical style. Reproductions were also manufactured, particularly in the first few years of the company's operation. The company found a niche market for the production of commercial furniture on contract to the specifications of architects and interior designers. James Bradley also designed furniture himself and offered a prototype service. In addition, production was undertaken of several pieces which were developed between the company and designers, particularly the Shoreline Reclining Deck Chair, designed by Leslie John Wright, and the Wood Chair, designed by Marc Newson. While these pieces provided only a small proportion of the income of James Bradley's Pty Ltd, they were important in building a profile for the company.

James Bradley's Pty Ltd specialised in cabinet making, upholstery, veneering, laminating and bending techniques. Veneering in particular was widely employed as a means of achieving both decorative effects and maximising scarce timber resources. A veneering plant was established in the factory in 1987. This enabled the company to supply veneers to other manufacturers and suppliers. The company utilised a wide variety of timbers. However, Australian native timbers, in particular those from Tasmania, were the preferred materials.

Major clients for whom James Bradley's Pty Ltd manufactured commercial furniture included the Parliament House Construction Authority (for example, the side table used by HRH Queen Elizabeth II at the opening of the new Parliament House); the Premier's Department, Hobart; the Commonwealth Bank Headquarters, Sydney; the State Bank of South Australia; Minter Ellison Solicitors, Sydney; the Australian Stock Exchange, Hobart; AMP, Hobart; the Sheraton Mirage, Surfers' Paradise; Jupiter's Casino, Gold Coast; and the Park Royal Hotel, Adelaide.

James Bradley's Pty Ltd began with three staff members and reached a peak of approximately 30.

In 1990, with the company established in the commercial furniture market, James Bradley decided that it should extend its operations into the production of furniture for the retail market. In order to gain experience in selling directly to consumers James Bradley's Pty Ltd took up a one third share in Anibou Pty Ltd, a Sydney furniture retailer. At the same time the Country Road clothing retail chain was also looking to extend its market into furniture, as well as other homewares such as soft furnishings. In 1991 James Bradley's Pty Ltd began manufacturing and supplying furniture to Country Road Retail for its Country Road Homewear venture. However, the company began to experience financial difficulties and did not survive the economic down turn of the early 1990s. It went into liquidation in April 1993.

The collection was donated to the Queen Victoria Museum and Art Gallery in 1993. Items in Sections 1, 3 and 4 of this guide are currently unavailable for public access. They are restricted for 25 years, in accordance with state archival practice under the *Archives Act 1983*, to protect personal and confidential commercial matters documented in the records.
