INTRODUCTION

Captain William Holyman arrived in Launceston from Hull in 1854. By 1898, with his sons William and James, he had built up a substantial sea trade (the White Star Line) serving the North West Coast, the Bass Strait Islands and Melbourne. In later years, the firm became known as William Holyman and Sons Pty Ltd. Victor Holyman, a grandson of Captain William Holyman, was the founder of the Australian National Airways (ANA), later known as Ansett Airlines.

The collection was donated to the Queen Victoria Museum and Art Gallery in 1982.
