#### INTRODUCTION

The first Australian Jaycee chapter was formed in Perth, Western Australia, in 1933, followed by Sydney, Melbourne, Adelaide, Brisbane and Launceston. Jaycees offered men (women were admitted many years later) between the ages of 18 to 40 years the opportunity to join with others in self development through training programs, community project activities and friendship and social activities. A non-political, non-sectarian organisation, Australian Jaycees formed a part of Jaycee International, an organisation in a number of countries with a world secretariat in Florida, USA.

A public meeting held in August 1945 resulted in the formation of the Launceston Junior Chamber of Commerce in October 1945 under a Launceston Chamber of Commerce by-law. It was the first chapter to be formed outside an Australian capital city. As one of the founding chapters of the National Association of Junior Chambers of Commerce in Australia, the Junior Chamber sent two delegates to the conference that established the national body in 1948.

In 1953 the Launceston Junior Chamber hosted the first national convention conducted in Tasmania. Meetings were held as luncheon and dinner meetings in various hotels before rented premises were obtained at 76 Wellington Street in 1961.

The by-law of the Launceston Chamber of Commerce was rescinded and Launceston Junior Chamber of Commerce became an autonomous body in 1962. Two years later the name was changed to Junior Chamber Launceston and in 1966 it was changed to Launceston Jaycees. The 19<sup>th</sup> national convention was hosted that year.

After the Wellington Street premises were vacated in 1975, meetings were held at the CTA Club in Charles Street, later at the Masonic Hall in Brisbane Street and from 1978 at the CTA Club in Wellington Street.

The 25<sup>th</sup> state conference was hosted at St Helens in 1977, the year the first female members were inducted into the chapter. In 1978 the Launceston Jaycee Youth Chapter was chartered for 13 to 18 year olds.

1979 was a memorable year that saw the completed construction of a project home, the chapter won a world award for aid to handicapped children for the asthma camp project and the Launceston Jaycees became incorporated as a company.

Launceston Jaycees Community Centre in the former Mulgrave Street Uniting Church in South Launceston was officially opened on 19 April 1980. The Centre was used for Launceston Jaycees meetings and for the storage of records of a number of northern chapters no longer operating. The centre was also let to community groups for their regular meetings and for various other uses.

The Launceston Junior Chamber of Commerce/Junior Chamber Launceston/Launceston Jaycees had a long history of involvement in national and local projects. These included the Darwin disaster doorknock, running the chocolate wheel at the Launceston Show, fun runs, road safety awareness and the underprivileged children's Christmas party. One of the best known projects was the Launceston Jaycees annual Asthmatic Children's Recreational Camp which commenced in 1977 and continued for some years.

The last Launceston Jaycees meeting recorded in the attendance register was held on 23 April 1997, although there is an issue of the newsletter, *Links*, for July 1997.

The collection was donated to the Queen Victoria Museum and Art Gallery in December 2003. Included in the collection are records of the Appledore, Bass, Burnie, Esk, George Town, Franklin Village, Longford and Riverside Jaycees chapters and the Northern Region Tasmanian Jaycees.
