INTRODUCTION

Gilbert Colville McKinlay was born on 16 May 1912 at Launceston, the son of George Colville and Susan Henty (nee McKay) McKinlay.

Educated at Miss Barnes' Preparatory School, Launceston Church Grammar School and Scotch College, Mr McKinlay commenced working in his grandfather, George Tennent McKinlay's shop, McKinlays Pty Ltd, in Brisbane Street in 1928. McKay, Sampson and McKinlay had traded on the same site since 1887. In 1937-38 he travelled extensively overseas to study the retail trade and also to enjoy his favourite pastime of skiing. He became managing director of McKinlays in 1944, then chairman and managing director from 1961 until the store closed in 1984.

On 7 April 1941, in Sydney, Mr McKinlay married Anne Love Colvin of Roseville, Sydney. Mrs McKinlay became an active member of the Australian Red Cross Society and the YWCA in Launceston. For her distinguished voluntary service to the Red Cross, she was awarded an honorary life medal in 1971. Mrs McKinlay died in 1987.

Mr McKinlay was a life member of the Launceston Chamber of Commerce, having been president 1957-58, a member of the executive committee of the LBS Statewide Bank 1947-1985, a formation member of the Northern Tasmanian branch of the Institute of Management, life member of the Retail Traders Association and Tasmanian representative on the Australian Retail Traders Association Council. He was involved with scouting, the Launceston YMCA, Apex, St Luke's Hospital, a member of the Rotary Club of Launceston and a Rotary Paul Harris Fellow. A keen bushwalker and skier, he was a foundation member of the Northern Tasmanian Alpine Club and a life member.

Mr McKinlay was awarded the Order of the British Empire in 1986 for his outstanding contribution to Tasmania's retail industry and the community of Launceston.

Gilbert McKinlay died on 24 September 2004 in Launceston at the age of 92.

The collection was donated to the Queen Victoria Museum and Art Gallery in 1984 when the Museum presented an exhibition to mark the closure of McKinlays Pty Ltd. Further donations were received in 1992, 1993 and 2003, with additional material donated in June 2004.
