The Bligh Collection belonged to 'Housewife Superstar' Marjorie Bligh, who passed away in September 2013. The collection was received on 19 May 2015.

1. Scrapbooks

Probably compiled from the 1950s to the 1960s. 1/4 A scrapbook being a paper covered hardboard volume of just 1965-68 Under 400 pages. Includes numerous items in magazine/newspaper cuttings format, there are also a wide variety of shop invoices, some greeting cards and postcards, letters from various media organisations. Contents are dated from about 1965 to 1968. 1/5 A scrapbook being a paper covered volume of 100 pages compiled 1990s in the early 1990s. Contains numerous clippings of a series "Word For Word" [derivation of words in cartoon format], a few "Today in History" [significant events], and small number of "Plain Talk" [quotations of note]. 1/6 A scrapbook being a spiral bound card-covered volume of about 1950s-60s 134 pages including covers, which contains items dated between 1921 and 1960. With compiler imposed title of "Mrs Blackwell's Country Scrapbook" it includes snippets from numerous newspapers and magazines, plus the occasional greeting card, ephemera, correspondence and photo. 1/7 A scrapbook being a spiral bound card-covered volume of 1969-70 about 82 pages including covers, which contains items mostly dated from 1969 to 1970. 1/8 A scrapbook being a large card-covered volume of 30 pages, 1973-74
