INTRODUCTION

In 1977 three Launceston churches, Paterson Street Methodist Church, Christ Church Congregational and Chalmers Presbyterian Church, joined together as part of the Uniting Church of Australia. Their records and associated material form this collection. The Uniting Church Launceston Central Parish congregation moved to the Pilgrim Uniting Church, formerly the Paterson Street Methodist Church, in July 1982 and Christ Church and Chalmers Church were sold.

The Paterson Street Methodist Sunday School commenced in 1835. The Paterson Street Methodist Church opened for worship in 1836 in the building later used as the Sunday School and now known as the Pilgrim Uniting Church Hall. The Paterson Street Methodist Church, now Pilgrim Uniting Church, opened for worship in 1868. Christ Church Congregational opened for worship in 1885 after the adjacent St John's Square/Prince's Square Congregational Church (the building now known as Milton Hall) became too small. St John's Square Independent Congregational Church had opened for worship in 1842. Chalmers Presbyterian Church opened for worship in 1860 although its congregation had been established in 1844. Histories of the three churches can be found in the select bibliography listed at the end of the records under heading Other Sources.

The early Prince's Square/Christ Church Congregational correspondence includes correspondence concerning the Congregational Union and Mission of Tasmania and north west coast Congregational churches, including those at Latrobe, Don, Formby, Forth, Leven and Devonport.

Some records from the Tamar Street Independent Congregational Church (opened for worship in 1837) whose congregation split to form the St John Square Independent Chapel, and Frederick Street Primitive Methodist Church (1862) are included. There are also fragmentary records for the Margaret Street Sunday School (commenced 1837), Chant Street Methodist Church (opened 1927), Launceston Methodist Circuit and Congregational Union of Tasmania. Other records are from Launceston based branches of religious organisations: the Colonial Missionary Society, London Missionary Society, Launceston Ministers' Fraternal Association, Mission to Chinese in Tasmania and Loyalty League/Protestant Federation.

The records were donated to the Queen Victoria Museum and Art Gallery by the Uniting Church Launceston Central Parish over a period of several years, from 1982 to 1985. They were arranged and described by Barbara Valentine in October 2004.
