INTRODUCTION

The collection consists mainly of Northern Tasmanian Football League (NTFL) programs for 1995 to 1999. These programs were compiled and edited by Thomas Gunn, who was general manager of the League from 1995 to 1999. The NTFL came into being at the end of 1986 with the emergence of the Tasmanian [Statewide] Football League. At that time the Northern Tasmanian Football Association and North West Football Union had fallen apart and it was realised that for clubs left outside the statewide competition to survive it was necessary to create a new northern body. After a number of meetings, the clubs remaining from those two old bodies established a new competition and 12 teams competed in 1987.

Other football records in the collection include *Amateur Voice*, the Tasmanian Amateur Football League Northern Division official football record for 1994 and 1995 and the *N.W.F.A. Centurian*, official record of the North Western Football Association (NWFA) for 1995: both publications were edited by Thomas Gunn. The NWFA is the oldest continuous football association in Tasmania, having been founded in 1894.

There are also some items relating to cricket, netball, softball, vigoro, horse-racing, pacing and trotting, with a date range from the 1920s to the 1990s.

The collection was donated to the Queen Victoria Museum and Art Gallery in December 2005, with additional items donated in January 2007, and July 2020 (family of late Peter Curran).
