INTRODUCTION

In August 1963 a group of wives of North Launceston Rotarians met to discuss the possibility of forming an Inner Wheel Club and a meeting was called for 14 August 1963. At this meeting Rotary Club of North Launceston President Harold Panitzki, the official who inaugurated the Club, said that whilst the Club would function as a body distinct from Rotary, its members would be the support of social functions conducted from time to time by the Rotary Club of North Launceston. The constitution was read and officers were elected.

The Inner Wheel Club of Launceston was the sponsor club at the double charter dinner of the Inner Wheel Club of North Launceston and the Inner Wheel Club of South Launceston on 6 March 1964.

When the Club applied for incorporation as an association in 1989 its objects and purposes were to promote friendship between the wives of Rotarians on a national and international level, thus fostering international understanding, and to raise funds for the purpose of donating to charitable organisations.

General meetings were held in members' homes every month except January and committee meetings were held regularly during the year. Guest speakers were invited to some general meetings and members enjoyed fellowship and friendship with other Inner Wheel clubs. The Club held numerous fundraising functions, with proceeds going to local charitable organisations and to international projects. Members also assisted at various Rotary Club events.

The Club was a member of Inner Wheel District 80 (Tasmania), formed on 15 June 1991, and of the Australian National Association of Inner Wheel Clubs, later called Inner Wheel Australia.

Declining membership and difficulty in recruiting office bearers caused the Inner Wheel Club of North Launceston to close on 30 June 2002.

The collection was donated to the Queen Victoria Museum and Art Gallery in July 2002.
