INTRODUCTION

The Northern Tasmanian Fisheries Association formed in 1893. It represented the interests of the northern angling community for over a century, although this became more of a consultative role in latter decades as the State Government took greater control of the management of inland fisheries.

The Association was made up of branches from across northern Tasmania and was one of three such bodies that represented Tasmania's three regions.

By the time of its disbandment in 2007, angling club membership was in decline and the Association had difficulty in electing sufficient committee members to function effectively.

Its collection of archives from the 1980s up until its disbandment came to the Queen Victoria Museum and Art Gallery in 2012. The Launceston Library holds the Association's archives from 1923 to 1976.
