INTRODUCTION

Austrian migrant Gustav Weindorfer (1874–1932) recognised Cradle Mountain's potential as a tourist resort and national park. Weindorfer and his wife Kate, both keen botanists, built Waldheim Chalet, opening it to guests in 1913. Following Kate's death in 1916, Gustav lived full-time at Waldheim, hosting visitors and promoting the area across Australia.

Lionel Connell (1884–1960) hunted in Cradle Valley from 1916. Following his friend Gustav Weindorfer's death, Connell first managed then purchased Waldheim and successfully developed it into a successful wilderness retreat. Connell was also the first Cradle Mountain ranger and was responsible for the development of much of the infrastructure in the northern half of what became the Cradle Mountain–Lake St Clair National Park.

The collection was donated to the Queen Victoria Museum and Art Gallery in 1987.
